VERSION 1: We have developed a sexual health and HIV prevention program for young adults in Uganda. People in the program receive text messages for about 5 months and will take 3 surveys.

We are looking for Ugandans like you to help test the program.

VERSION 2: We are looking for young adults to help test a sexual health and HIV prevention program. Messages are sent by texting, so all you have to do is have a mobile phone!

How does the research program work?

Your participation would last for about 5 months:

- 1. You would receive program text messages that talk about HIV prevention and sexual health topics for 5 months.
- You will be asked to complete 3 surveys at different times in the program: Two of the surveys take one hour to complete and can be completed online or on the telephone with program staff. The other survey is short and can be completed by text messaging.

Your participation will help us know if the program helps people make decisions that keep them healthy.

This research study is a joint collaboration between Internet Solutions for Kids - Uganda, an NGO in Uganda; and the Center for Innovative Public Health Research, an NGO in the United States. The study is funded by the National Institutes of Health in the United States.

You do not have to pay to be in the research study. To enroll, you will have to talk to our staff on the phone.
